Summer is here and so are those PESKY Bugs!



Find out what you can do to help keep bugs at bay, and protect local waterways!

Did you know that when pesticides are sprayed on your lawn or garden, water from rain or over watering can wash these chemicals directly into the storm drains and into local waterways? Unlike sanitary sewer systems, the water in storm drains is not treated before it reaches our local

creeks and the San Francisco Bay. While pesticides are designed to be toxic to certain organisms, they can often kill other species in the marine systems that are important for the entire ecosystem. You can help reduce pesticide pollution:

- Purchase beneficial insects such as ladybugs to eat up destructive pests like aphids on your plants.
- · Grow native plants which have natural defenses to ward off insect pests and diseases.
- Don't apply pesticides if it is windy, when rain is predicted, or prior to watering your lawn or garden.
- Avoid applying pesticides to sidewalks, driveways, and other hard surfaces.
