DON'T GET STUCK WITH YOUR SHARPS: Dispose Of Them Properly!

n September 1, 2008, a new law has taken effect, which will make it illegal to place home generated sharps in trash or recycling receptacles. Home generated sharps are needles, syringes, and lancets that assist people who use sharps or syringes at home to manage an illness. When sharps are improperly disposed of they pose a threat to children, adults, sanitation workers, and even pets. Here's how to properly and safely dispose of your sharps:

Note: Residents MUST place sharps in a biohazard sharps container, which are available for purchase at your local pharmacy, before bringing to any of the approved sharps drop-off locations.

- Pharmacies, Doctor's Offices or Clinics: Contact your local Pharmacy, Medical Clinic, or personal Physician and ask if they can start a take back program.
- ♦ Mail Back Services: If you purchase sharps on-line, please remember to request a preaddressed, prepaid mail-back box for your used sharps. A list of mail back services can be found at http://www.cdph. ca.gov/certlic/medicalwaste

Deposit used home-generated sharps into a biohazard sharps container, when the container is 3/4 full permanently seal shut and make an appointment through our website at **www.hhw.org** or call (408)-299-7300

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

Collection occurs on all holidays except December 25th and January 1st.

Both December 25th 2008 and January 1st 2009 fall on Thursday. During these weeks, if your regular collection day is Thursday collection will occur on Friday. If your regular collection day is Friday collection will occur on Saturday. No other collection days will be affected.

HOLIDAY TREE COLLECTION

Beginning December 26th 2008 and continuing through **January 25th 2009,** WVC&R will collect up to two Holiday trees per residence as part of your regular collection.

- Undecorated natural or flocked holiday trees are acceptable.
- Please remove stands, tinsel and decorations.
- All trees must be cut into 5-foot or preferably shorter lengths.
- Place the tree at least one foot away from WVC&R carts.

If you have clothing that is shredded or not in "wearable" condition, you can always recycle them! Tie fabrics in a clear plastic bag and place in your recycling cart for collection. We'll do the rest. Acceptable Items: Clean cotton, linen, polyester, rayon and wool fabrics (e.g. blankets, clothes, cloth diapers, rags, sheets) NO rags or textiles soiled with chemicals, oil or paint. NO Shoes, Carpets, Disposable diapers, Down-filled items, Leather, Nylon, Pillows, Rubber, Stuffed animals, Vinyl.

MAKE IT A GREEN HOLIDAY

Thinking green begins long before you determine which item goes into your garbage cart and which one goes in your recycling cart. It starts with knowing which materials to buy at the store that reduce waste in your household. So remember to always look for the recycle triangle when you buy.
